

We have 2 members who have invited us to their gardens, so far: Valerie Bishop and Lori Regni




Alyce Miller

Sonja Walcker said that the nuns told her that the colorful mini chapels were bird houses. They said that she could take pictures but not with them in the photos.










I thought the Monks' private dining hall would be a restricted area until an unnamed member sent me this picture. I didn't see this. Starla

















